It's not quite clear who the older people in the picture are. *The students could come up with* a variety of answers as long as they give a reason for their guesses, i.e. the girl on Emma's left could be Jane because she is young and beautiful. The lady under the large umbrella could be Jane's Aunt because she looks a little older than the others.
