- 5** Because she wants to make a film report about Sheila for her TV station. The station is making a short film about teenagers and their summer jobs.
- 6** Because Jen has been kind to him. Now he thinks, "Jen is in love with me. She doesn't want me to talk with other girls. She is jealous."
- 7** 1 Because Dawson is angry when he sees Joey with Jeremy Fields. He has told Sheila, "Joey is not my girlfriend." But Sheila doesn't believe him. He is angry about Joey, and Sheila is amused by this.
- 2 Because Pacey has not been listening to him in the class.
- 8** Because the song makes her think of her dead mother. Her mother had loved that song.
- 9** 1 He had arranged to meet Joey that morning. But he had forgotten about this.
- 2 He loves Joey. He has understood this at last.
