4 Heidi's grandfather – **Uncle Alp**

Clara's father, who travels a lot for his work – **Mr Sesemann**

Heidi's aunt, who moves to Germany - **Detie**

The tall and thin housekeeper at Clara's house – **Mrs Rottenmeier**

Bridget's mother, who is blind and likes listening to stories - **Grannie**

Heidi's friend and companion, who is too weak and ill to walk - **Clara**

Clara's grandmother, who gives Heidi a book when she learns to read – **Mrs Sesemann (Grandmamma)**

Heidi's friend who looks after goats - **Peter**

The teacher in Frankfurt who teaches Heidi to read – **Mr Usher**

Peter's mother - **Bridget**

The man who looks after Clara's health, but has no family since his daughter died – **Doctor Classen**

5 a *Examples may include:*

Person helped	By which person?	How are they helped?
Heidi	Uncle Alp	He makes her a chair and a bed of hay in the loft. He gives her food and drink.
Peter	Heidi	She gives him her food. She helps him learn to read, so that he can read to Grannie.
Grannie	Heidi	She visits her and reads to her. She brings her presents, including soft rolls and a bed.
Grannie	Uncle Alp	He repairs her house.
Clara	Heidi	She is her friend and companion. She invites Clara to stay with her in the mountains, where she helps her get better and walk.
Heidi	Mrs Sesemann	She says she will give her a book if she learns to read.
Heidi	Mr Sesemann	He agrees that Heidi can go home. He gives her money for a bed and clothes.
Heidi	Doctor Classen	He understands she is homesick and tells Mr Sesemann to send her back to the mountains.
Clara	Peter	He pushes her wheelchair off the mountain, which encourages her to try to walk.
