1 Student's own answer. *The most likely answers are: (c), (e) and (a). (d) is less likely. (b) is very unlikely. Students could justify their answers in their own language.*

3 Student's own answer. *Frank may remember Max was his friend, he may feel sad/guilty, he may wonder why Max jumped, what job Max was doing, what FSI does, he may think about Angela and the children.*

3 Student's own answer. *Ideas for possible answers: Stuart is pleased he has found some money. Maybe he is wondering who to give the money to. Maybe he is thinking that now he can buy the motorbike.*

4 Student's own answer.  
 (1) *Frank may ask what Stuart has behind his back. Stuart probably won't tell him.*  
 (2) *Stuart may ask why Frank is looking at the mattress. Frank may say there is a hole in it. He may say Stuart has made the hole.*

5 Student's own answer. *Ideas for possible answers: Frank will go on looking for Stuart. Stuart will go to the garage and buy the motorbike.*
