## Das Verb *to be* im *past simple* (einfache Vergangenheit) → S. 47

Das *past simple* wird gebraucht, um über vergangene Ereignisse zu sprechen, oft in Verbindung mit einer Zeitangabe wie z.B. *yesterday, last year*.

Aussage	positiv	negativ
I, he, she, it	<b>was</b>	<b>wasn't</b>
we, you, they	<b>were</b>	<b>weren't</b>

Frage	Kurzantwort positiv	Kurzantwort negativ
<b>Was</b> I, he, she, it ...?	Yes, I, he, she, it <b>was.</b>	No, I, he, she, it <b>wasn't.</b>
<b>Were</b> we, you, they ...?	Yes, we, you, they <b>were.</b>	No, we, you, they <b>weren't.</b>

Bei den meisten regelmäßigen Verben wird das *past simple* durch das Anhängen von *-ed* gebildet. Endet ein Verb auf *e*, folgt nur *-d*. Die unregelmäßigen Formen müssen auswendig gelernt werden.

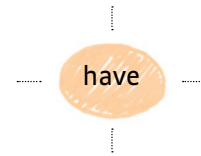
